This individual would join the product team that produces our industry-leading web and client-server based datacenter management applications. Technologies used include Microsoft .NET, ASP.NET, SQL Server, Microsoft Office components and a number of others.

Initial projects will include the creation and execution of software testing plans for client-server and web-based applications. The candidate will be responsible for test planning, test implementation and test execution using industry standard techniques to assure quality and identify potential improvement in testing procedure and processes. In addition, you will be responsible for researching, locating and developing innovative automated testing infrastructures and methodologies to reduce dependency on manual testing. You will work on a product team, where we would expect you to help others learn and learn from them while producing world-class applications.

Experience: Experience in testing commercial software applications in the Microsoft and web programming environments, with an emphasis on experience on modern software testing methodologies, tools and techniques. Required Skills: The Product Test Engineer position requires a thorough knowledge of software product test best practices with a proven track record of contributing creative solutions both as an individual and on a team.

Designing, implementing and executing test plans, test cases, load/performance tests, and experience with test automation for Microsoft based client-server and web applications is required. In addition, this position requires experience in writing test planning documentation, logging defects into defect tracking products, experience with enterprise application installation, configuration and testing of SQL databases. Commercial software development and/or experience developing software applications for MS Windows client and web applications are a plus.
